COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is specifically designed for individuals who may be required to perform a high angle rescue in a multitude of different situations (i.e. as a member of an emergency response team). Situations from ladder cage loop entanglements, to crane operator retrievals, to extraction from pits, and many more will be addressed in this advanced learning program.

This two-day program will introduce the inclusion of the Incident Response System to assist rescue team members to remain organized, safe and efficient during emergency retrieval situations.

Under the watchful eye of the instructors, students will be challenged to complete a variety of involved rescue scenarios, implementing primary and secondary systems. The objective will be to apply concepts learned during all three levels of training in a successful manner.
